We know your friendly pup may listen to your commands at home but please remember to walk your dog with a leash. Not only for their safety but to comply with Arizona Leash Law; dogs must be on a leash no more than 6ft long and directly under the owner's control.

Please be courteous to your neighbors and be mindful where your dog goes to the bathroom. Cochise County Law requires dog owners to scoop and dispose of their dog's waste in a proper manner. Please utilize the dog waste receptacles around the neighborhood.

Community Reminders

Vista View Residents, thank you for following our community reminders. We have these reminders set to keep our community safe, as well as informed. These are from our Rules and Regulations as well as our Exclusive Lot Agreement that everyone signs when they purchase at Vista View. If you have any questions, please contact our office.

- **Keys:** To replace lost pool/clubhouse/fitness center keys there is a fee of \$20.00 per key. To replace lost or broken gate remotes there is fee of \$50.00.
- RV Dumpsters: The RV dumpsters are not for homeowners to use. These are specifically for the RV guests. Homeowners will be fined. RV guests need to break down boxes. Please do not leave them next to the dumpster.
- Architectural Requests: Architectural requests must be submitted and approved PRIOR to starting any exterior house or lot improvements. This includes plants/trees, house painting, sheds, furniture visible from the street or yard, adding a wall or fence, gates, solar systems, flag poles, and decorative yard features, etc. This is to maintain the aesthetics and consistency of the community.
- **Street Lights:** Everyone's "lollipop" light must be in working order and turned on during the evening hours to light the sidewalk area. This is a resident responsibility.
- Speed Limits: Neighborhood speed limit is 15 MPH and in the RV area 5 MPH. Please make sure you and your guests/vendors are following these posted limits to ensure the safety of all of our residents. There are many violators.



Vista View Parking Issues

Vista View is currently reviewing ALL of the CC&R's, Rules & Regulations, Statement of Policy, and Exclusive Lot Agreements for some long overdue updates regarding parking as well as other pertinent resident items.

In the meantime, the following updates will take effect immediately or as otherwise indicated:

- Visa View Resort residents and guest will comply with ARS 28-873 - A vehicle, trailer, golf cart, & RV cannot block a sidewalk: Except if necessary to avoid conflict
- 2. with other traffic or if in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device. A person shall not stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the following places: 1. On a sidewalk. 2. In a private



- driveway if any part of the vehicle or an attachment to the vehicle, including a hitch or trailer, blocks an area of a sidewalk and impedes continuous pedestrian use of the sidewalk in a manner that is not consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act as defined in section 41-1492. This paragraph does not apply if the vehicle is temporarily parked for the purposes of loading or unloading the vehicle. 3. In front of a public or private driveway.
- 3. Vista View Resort residents and guests will comply with ARS 28-874 a person who stops or parks a vehicle on a roadway where there are adjacent curbs shall stop or park the vehicle with its right-hand wheels parallel to and within eighteen inches of the right-hand curb. Parking on the curb is prohibited. A simple translation of this code means vehicles may not be parked against the flow of traffic on the street.
- 4. Vista View Resort residents and guests, if using their driveways for vehicle parking, must be facing perpendicular to the garage with either the front or back of the vehicle facing the garage door. At no time may a vehicle be parked parallel or crooked to the sidewalk as a means to avoid parking on the sidewalk to try to circumvent Arizona Revised Statutes or Vista View Rules and Regulations, CC&Rs and/or Exclusive Lot Agreements. Every home was built at Vista View with two car garages (except for carports for manufactured homes) with the intention of residents using their garages for the primary storage of their vehicles. With this in mind, please use your garages accordingly.
- 5. Vehicles or golf carts at no time may be parked on the gravel portion of any lot or common area, unless specifically marked as overflow parking.
- 6. Lots that are currently in use for overflow parking are for daily parking only. Vehicle's parked for over three days vehicle will be towed at owners' expense. There are several lots/parking areas that Vista View Resort is currently in the process of replacing old or missing signs. This includes the parking by the model homes & sales office, the Clubhouse parking lot, and the RV parking area.
- 7. Parking on the street is allowed. Overnight parking on the street is not allowed. Common hours of observance are 10:00pm 6:00am.

Parking Issues Continued...

The parking of vehicles has a direct impact on the aesthetic. harmony, and consistency of the community, in addition to the safety of our community as a whole. Vista View Resort sidewalks were made to be used by our residents. While the resort is an "active adult" community, many of the resort's residents and/or guests have limited mobility and we must comply with ADA requirements and Arizona laws across the board. It is not Vista View Resort's intent to "police" our residents, but instead for our residents to take these "rules" and follow them for the betterment of the entire community. Vista View staff, when time allows, will be spot-checking the community. Staff will attempt to notify residents of these rule violations by either phone, email, or mail. When the owner of said vehicle is not known, or after unsuccessful attempts of notifying the resident or guest, a tag may be placed on the vehicle. If no action is taken, staff may contact a towing service to remove the vehicle. We will never patrol for these violations 24/7, nor do we want residents to contact the office in regards to repeat offenders. When there is a formal complaint, please complain wisely and considerately for all involved. Most of these items can be dealt with reasonably and over time. In most situations, these are not an emergency and don't need immediate action. When asked to move your vehicle by a staff member, please take immediate action. If you need a more permanent solution, please consider renting one of our RV dry storage spaces.

Again, as the community grows, Vista View will be reviewing and updating our Rules and Regulations and other legal documentation accordingly. Not using your garages as intended for vehicle storage has a direct impact on how this community looks and also impacts the values of your homes.




